Eleven-month-old Macy, her mom, and three siblings were found outside by a Good Samaritan who called PAWS for assistance.

Her mom and siblings were fine and have since been adopted, but her foster mom noticed right away that Macy had a wobbly gait and jerky movements. She was brought to the vet to be checked out and was diagnosed with Cerebellar Hyperplasia (CH), which is a neurological condition in which part of the brain is smaller than usual or not completely developed.



CH is not contagious or painful, but it is a lifelong condition that will never get better nor worsen.



Macy does NOT want anyone to feel bad or sorry for her!

She was born this way, and, other than having a hard time walking and balancing, Macy can have a normal, happy, healthy life.

She loves any toy that moves but her favorite toys are sponge balls! She loves to eat and especially loves her cat treats.

Although she enjoys playing with the other cats in her foster home, her favorite buddy is Wallace.

Wallace is a 12-year-old black lab mix. She loves to cuddle with him when they take their afternoon nap. However, at night, she prefers to cuddle with her foster mom.



Macy's foster mom believes that Macy would greatly benefit from a wheelchair to help increase her strength and mobility. A wheelchair will not increase the use of her hind legs, but it will help her to move around more easily.
